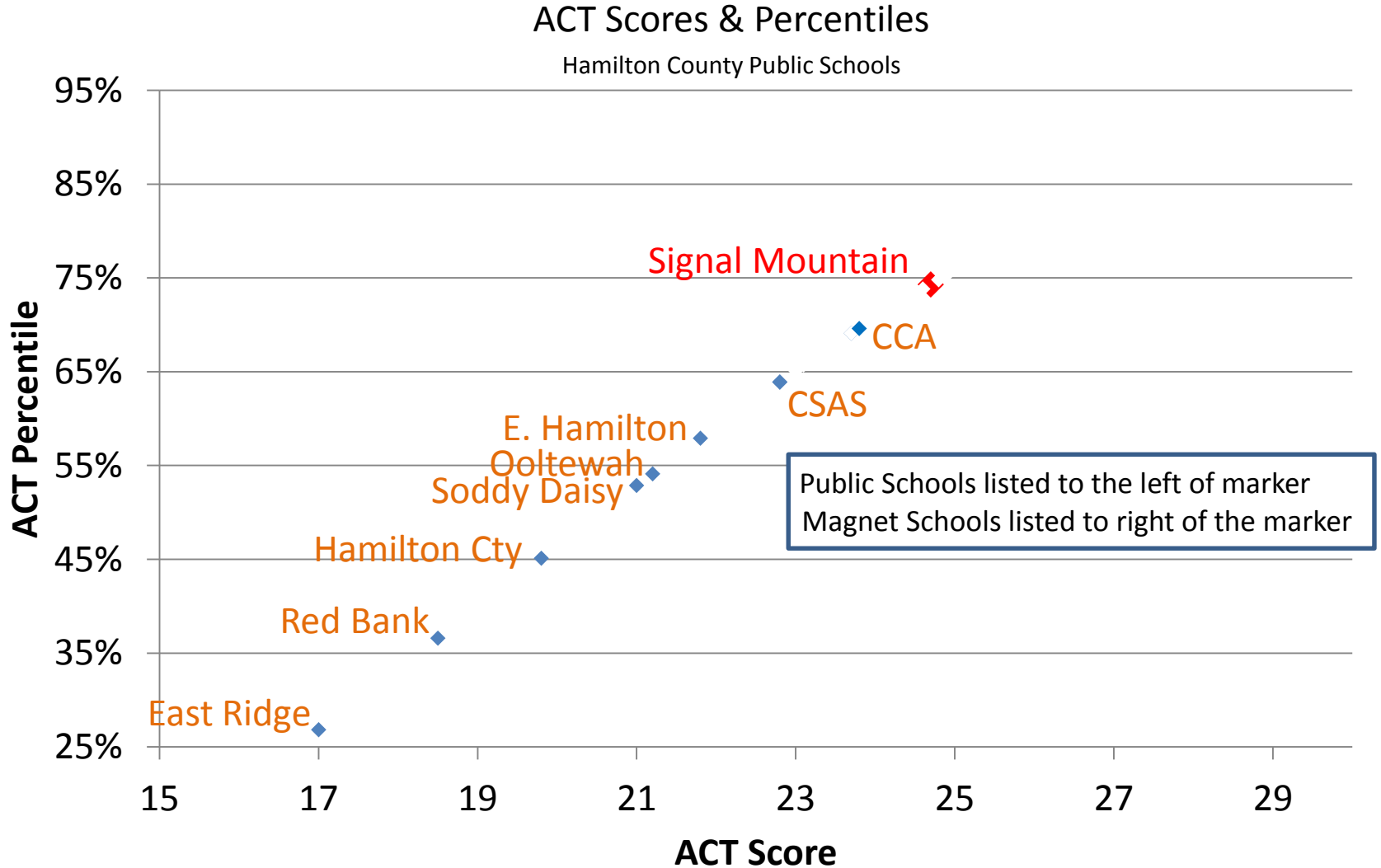
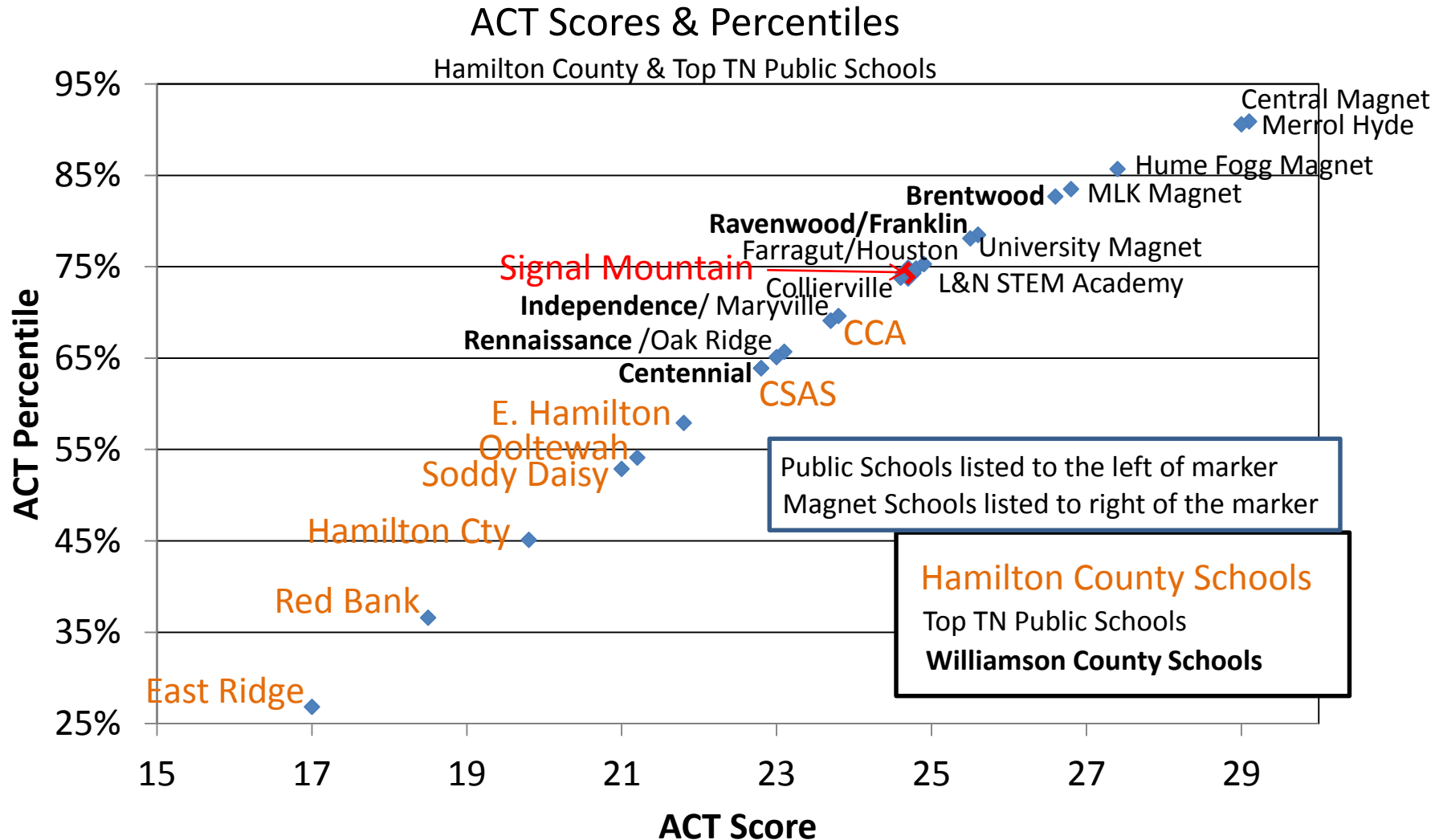


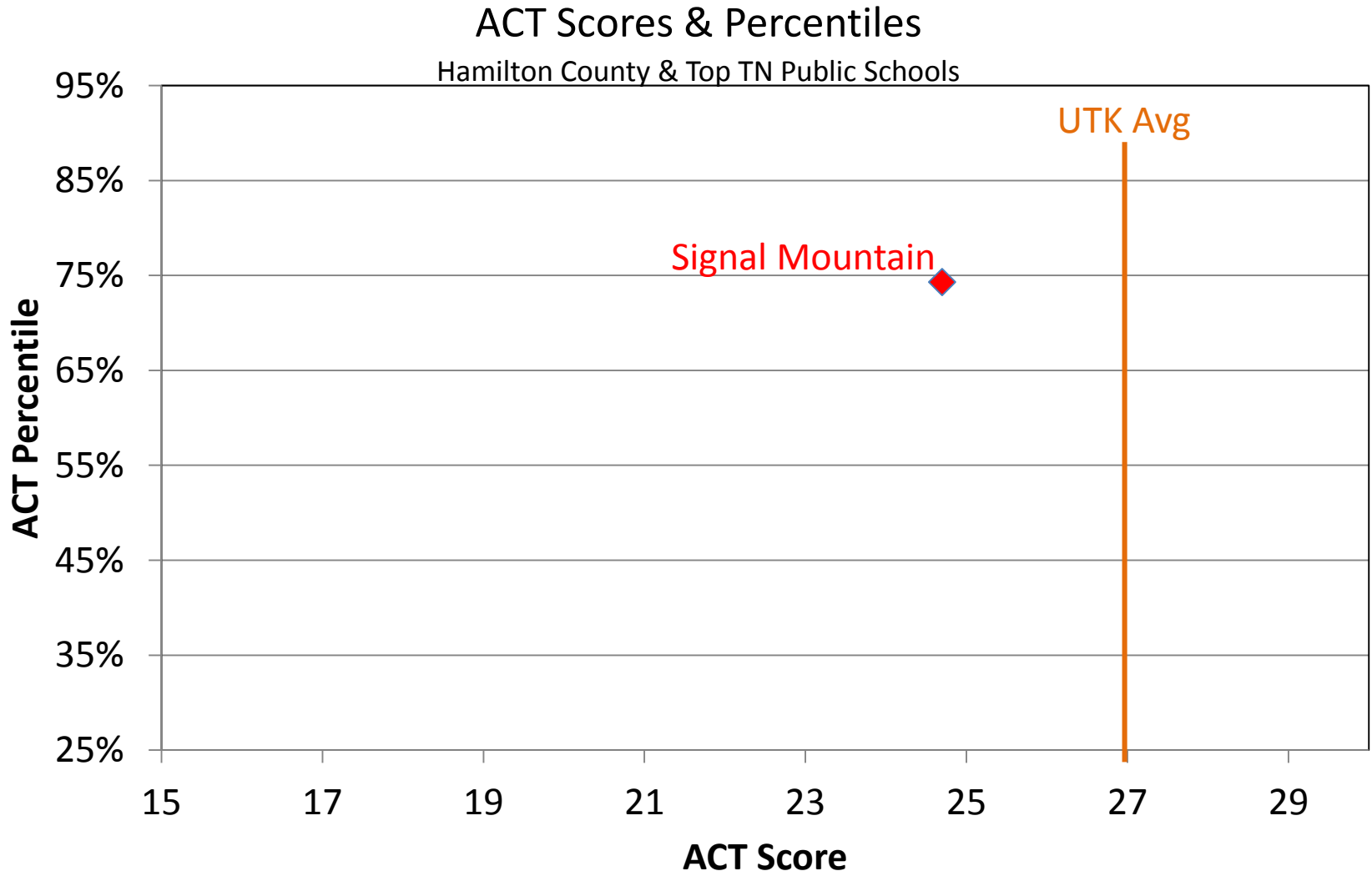

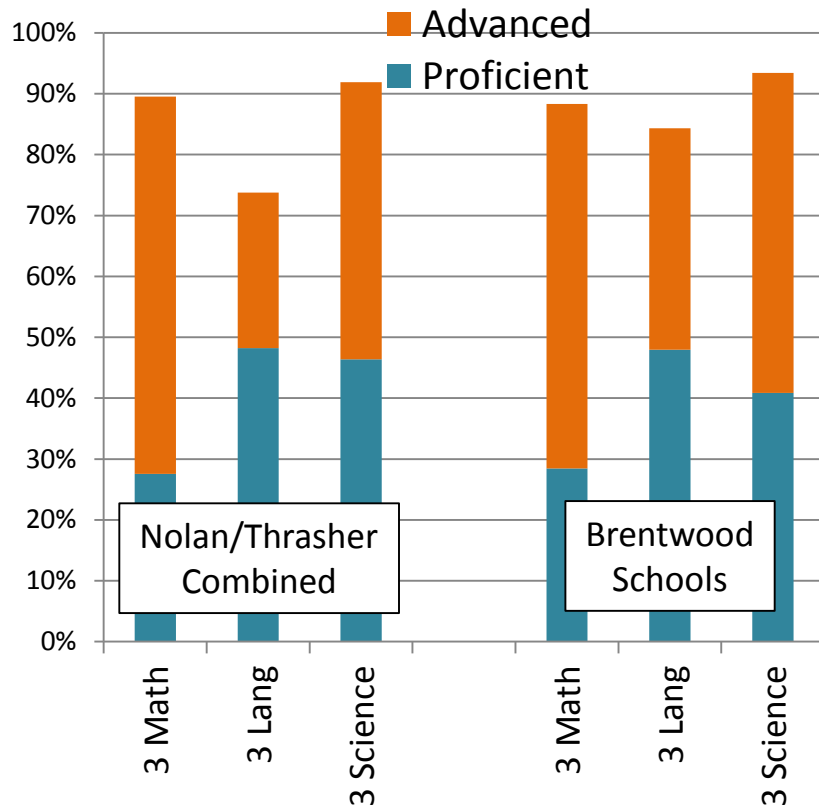
# Based on % of Students Testing “At or Above Grade Level”

## Thrasher/Nolan Scores Near Top In TN...SMMHS Lags Behind

- Test results for Nolan & Thrasher Students on par with top community in TN with roughly 90% of students scoring “At or Above Grade Level”.
- In high school, Signal Mountain lags behind this same community with 70% testing “At or Above Grade Level” across most subjects. Signal Mountain also has less students scoring “Advanced”.

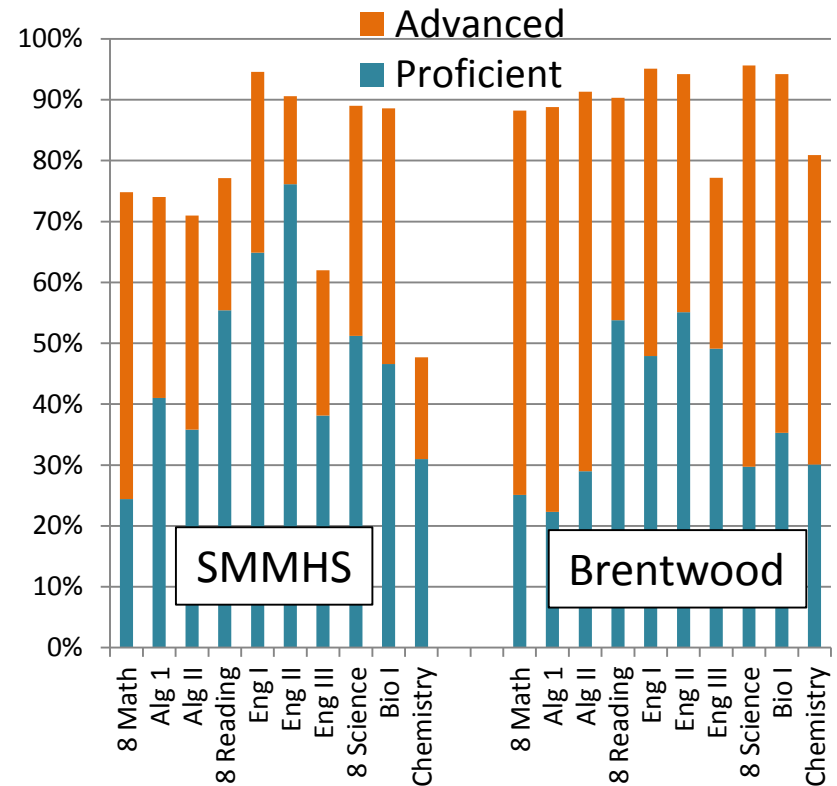
### % “At or Above Grade Level: TCAP Testing

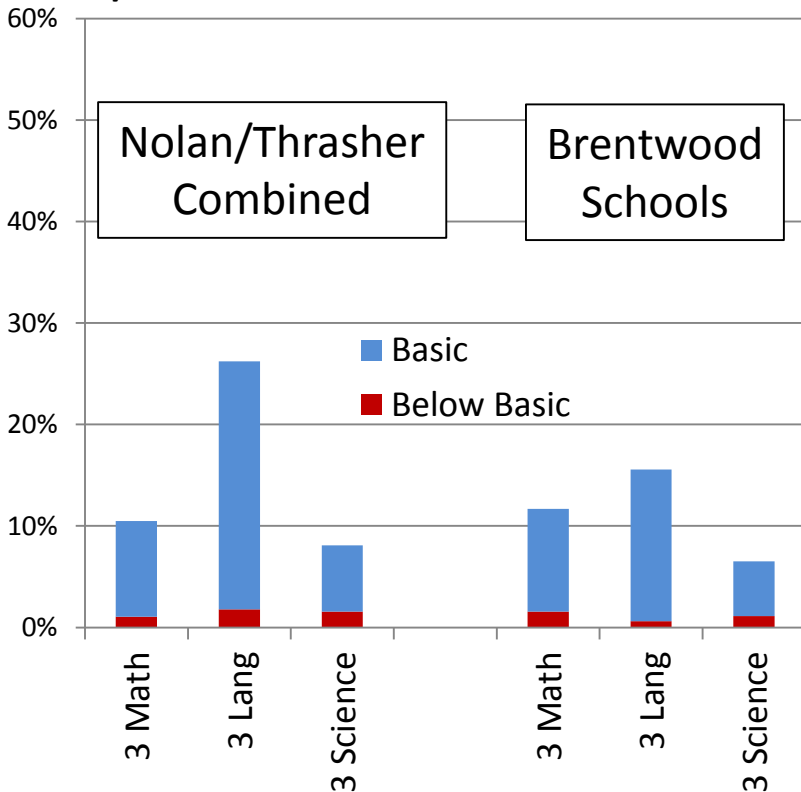
# Based on % of Students Testing “Below Grade Level”

## Thrasher/Nolan Scores Near Best In TN...SMMHS Lags Behind

- Test scores of Nolan & Thrasher students on par with the top community in TN with roughly 10% of students scoring “Below Grade Level”.
- In high school, Signal Mountain has roughly 25% of students across most subjects testing “Below Grade Level”. This is worse than the same community in which they compare favorably in elementary.

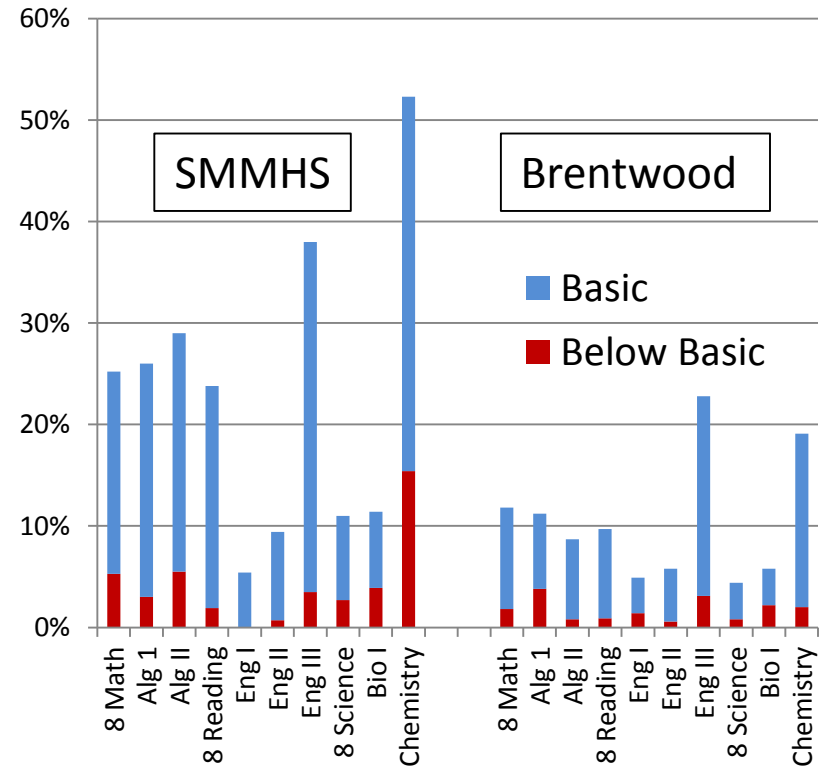
